

Expectations for WPCS Middle School

There are four classroom expectations in the classroom. These are called the “**4BPs**”

1. **Be Prepared:** Come to class dressed according to the dress code. Bring supplies to class everyday and be prepared to hand in completed homework assignments on time.
2. **Be Punctual:** Be on time and ready to participate by being seated when the tardy bell rings. Class will start and end on time. A student who is 10 minutes late is truant.
3. **Be Productive:** Students are required to actively participate in all class assignments and activities. Only class related activities are allowed in class.
4. **Be Polite:** Respectful yourself and others. It is also mandatory to show respect toward other’s belongings and school property.

If any student chooses not to follow these expectations the following consequences will result:

1. Verbal warning X 2
2. Option Card or One-on-One
3. Penalty Box and One-on-One Conference
4. Lunch detention and fill out an Action Plan
5. Sent to principal’s office and phone call home

* In case of a serious infraction, the levels will be skipped immediately to higher consequences.

** If students choose to follow the class rules then there will be positive consequences for the students and they will be rewarded for their good behaviors. (Discussion of PAT Time)
